Disclaimer: Cost of attendance (COA) is an estimated amount of student's educational expenses (Direct/Indirect Costs) for an enrollment period. Direct Costs are billed directly by the school to the student. Indirect costs are an estimate of out-of-pocket expenses an average student may have. The COA number is used to determine the maximum amount of financial aid (loans, scholarships, stipends, outside aid, etc.) a student may receive for an award year. Educational expenses do not include costs for: relocation, deposits, credit card debt, consumer debt, spousal expenses or vehicle purchase/lease or expenses outside of the number of months in the COA budget.

In limited circumstances, individual students may request a COA adjustment for reasonable extenuating circumstances, such as: major car repair, daycare, disability related expenses or other academically related expenses. All requests will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis for approval or denial by the Financial Aid Office.
