To All ACHE Students:

Please be advised that the DO (OMS-1 and OMS-2) and MSB curricula will be delivered virtually beginning Monday, November 30, 2020, following the Thanksgiving break. Dean McClain has worked with the ARCOM and MSB leadership to develop a revised schedule to deliver the curriculum virtually and to make necessary modifications for all practicals, as well as the exam schedule. The revised curricular schedule will be available to students by no later than the close of business on Monday, November 9, 2020. OMS-3 and OMS-4 students are expected to continue with their current rotation schedules.

As might be expected, should students travel during the Thanksgiving break, returning to ACHE from their Thanksgiving destinations would pose unnecessary risks to the ACHE community, particularly with a large group of travelers among the student body. Accordingly, the administration has decided to have students continue with the curriculum virtually after they leave for Thanksgiving and return in January at the beginning of the spring term.

If students choose to remain on campus during and after the Thanksgiving break, please note that access to ACHE buildings will be limited during this time. The CoHSc building will close at 4 PM, and the ARCOM building will close at 8 PM. In addition, extended access to the ARCOM building will no longer be available after the closing time. Cleaning will continue during the 10 AM – 12 PM block for the ARCOM building and 9 AM – 10 AM block for the CoHSc building. ACHE police will continue to keep all facilities secured 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
