Arkansas Association of Student Financial Aid Administrators

Arkansas students attending school at ACHE are eligible to apply for two \$500 scholarships the Arkansas Association of Student Financial Aid Administrators awards to students attending at a member institution. Application deadline is typically April 1st.

Arkansas Rehabilitation Services

Students that are Arkansas residents who have a qualifying disability may be eligible to apply for assistance through Arkansas Rehabilitation Services.

ASLA Scholarship Search

College Board

Scholarship information is provided to students based upon the College Board's Annual Survey of Financial Aid Programs.

Fleet Reserve Association

Students who are affiliated with the U.S. Navy, Marine Corps or Coast Guard through their own service or that of a spouse, parent, grandparent, or great-grandparent may be eligible to apply for scholarships. Applications typically open from September 1st to April 15th.

Mapping Your Future

Students may be eligible to apply for scholarships based upon their major, work, experience, and activities.

Marine Gunnery Sergeant John David Fry Scholarship (Fry Scholarship)

Students who have had a parent or spouse that was an active-duty service member who died in the line of duty on or after September 11, 2001, may qualify for this benefit.

Segal AmeriCorps Education Award

Individuals who complete approved terms of national service in the AmeriCorps program may use educational expenses or to repay qualified student loans. The dollar amount of the education award is equal to the maximum amount of the U.S. Department of Education Pell Grant and may change from year to year.

SMART Scholarship-for-Service Program

Undergraduate or graduate students pursuing a degree in one of 21 STEM disciplines outlined on their website that in good standing with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 who are willing to accept post-graduation employment with the DoD.

State Grant Agency

Students may be eligible to apply for financial assistance through your state grant agency.
