Occupational Therapy Scholarships

AMBUCS Scholarship Program

Open to physical therapy, occupational therapy, speech language pathology and hearing audiology with awarding from \$600 to \$6,000. Applications typically open February to May 1st.

AOTA E.K. Wise Scholarship

The fund for the E. K. Wise scholarship was established in the 1960s through the generous bequest of Elizabeth K. Wise and supports students pursuing an entry-level occupational therapy (OT) or occupational therapy assistant (OTA) degree from diverse backgrounds. Yearly, three awards will be granted in the amount of \$2,500. Students may apply for a second year. Applications typically open in February.

 Focus on ergonomics for a \$500 scholarship.

 Open to occupational therapy students with priority given to residents of AZ, CA, FL, IN, KY, MO of a \$1,500 scholarship.
- Linda Bottom Memorial Scholarship
 Preference given to those active in public policy.
- Martha Kirkland Pi Theta Epislon (PTE) Endowed Scholarship Members of PTE who demonstrate leadership potential and aspire to roles in education, practice or research.

Civil Servant Agencies - Service Agreement

Medical students who are interested in committing to future service working as a civil service (public sector employee working for a government department or agency) that meet the qualifying criteria for a scholarship, loan repayment assistance, or loan forgiveness may be eligible to apply through the below agencies as well as other federal agencies.

• Indian Health Service (IHS)

Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR)

Applicants must be citizens of the United States to apply for a scholarship offered by the DAR Scholarship Committee.

Applicants must also attend or plan to attend an accredited college or university in the United States.

Occupational/Physical Therapy Scholarship

The Occupational/Physical Therapy Scholarship, in the amount of \$2,000, is awarded to two students who are in financial need and have been accepted or are attending an accredited school of occupational therapy (including art, music, or physical therapy).

Health Career Scholarships

IOKDS provides annual Health Career Scholarship application to pharmacy, occupational therapy, physical therapy, speech therapy and medical technology students who have completed a minimum of two years of study. Applications typically open November 1st to March 1st.

HIE Help Center Scholarship

Open to students seeking to pursue physical, occupational or therapy with a minimum GPA of 3.0. Applications typically open in January.
