



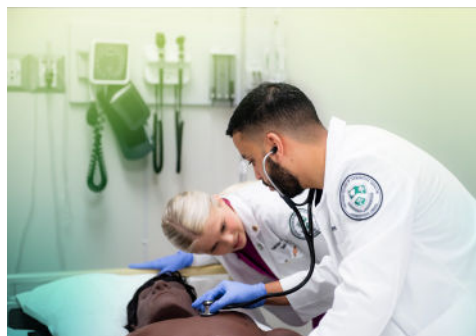
ACHE | ARKANSAS COLLEGES OF HEALTH EDUCATION

An aging population, demographics changes, and a shortage of primary care doctors and healthcare professionals presents significant challenges to our region.
